




With only two cooling seasons remaining before R-22 production allowances reach 0, have you prepared your facility and equipment?

WHAT IS THE R-22 PHASE OUT?

Equipment manufacturers, refrigerant suppliers and distributors have all been preparing for the **January 1, 2020 cutoff** when no new or imported R-22 refrigerant will be allowed in the U.S. There are two cooling seasons remaining before R-22 production allowances reach 0.

### REFRIGERANT MANAGEMENT PLANNING: THE SEVEN R'S



#### RECORDKEEPING

Equipment owners are legally responsible for **keeping records** about maintenance of your equipment. For Rieck customers, we have kept those records for you.



#### **REPAIR**

**Repair** leaks and maintain equipment performance. This is not only the right thing to do for the environment, but refrigerant loss is in direct correlation with how well your system operates.



#### **RETROFIT**

**Retrofit** your existing equipment with R-22 alternatives.



#### **REPLACE**


**Replace** equipment that has reached the end of its useful life – this is a necessary part of your equipment plan.



#### **RECOVER, RECYCLE & RECLAIM**

**Recover** refrigerant out of equipment before you dispose of it or before you put another gas in. **Recycle** gas by putting it back into another piece of equipment owned by the **same owner**. **Reclaim** refrigerant means reprocessing it by returning to a refrigerant reclaim center for proper EPA processing. Refrigerant reclamation facilities must be certified by the U.S. EPA.
